

Accommodation

Below are a number of accommodation options that we recommend for the conference, as they offer good value and facilities, close to the main University of Melbourne campus in Parkville.

However you should note that the Double Dialogues conference is being held at the Victorian College of the Arts on the Southbank campus, 234 St Kilda Rd Southbank VIC 3006, just across the river and near the Victorian Arts Centre (i.e. just the other side of the central business district from the Parkville campus).

They are listed from the most expensive to the cheapest, and range from five star hotels to hostels.

All prices are quoted in Australian dollars. Prices were correct as of June 2006, so may well have increased slightly since then. Please check before booking!

The University of Melbourne Graduate Club is situated opposite the university's Parkville campus, and offers high-quality accommodation and facilities, including breakfast every day, and dinner from Monday to Friday.

The standard room in the Graduate Club Building (\$100/night) features excellent modern accommodation, including single bed, en suite, telephone and internet-access port, and desk. Double and twin rooms in this building are available for \$150/night.

The Graduate House Terraces next door offer older-style student accommodation in traditional terrace buildings, with shared bathrooms (men's and women's). Single rooms in the terraces are \$80/night and include single bed, desk and wardrobe. There are some deluxe single rooms with balcony for \$85/night, and double and twin rooms in the terraces are \$105 per night.

Accommodation at Graduate House is in high demand so it is strongly recommended that you make your booking as early as possible.

These apartments offer fully self-contained accommodation but also allow access to all the facilities of University College. The college is in pleasant grounds on the fringe of the university, ten minutes walk from the centre of the Parkville campus, or a 25 minute tram ride to the Southbank campus. Apartments include telephone, internet access, kitchen (kitchenette in the small apartments), refrigerator and television. Three meals a day are provided in the dining hall, with the option of a packed lunch.

There are very limited numbers of apartments available, so we advise that you book early.

This hostel is set in a historic former nunnery, and offers dormitories and some private rooms. It is a fifteen minute walk from the Parkville campus, across the beautiful Carlton Gardens. Take the number 96 tram into the city (Swanston St), and then transfer to any tram that runs down Swanston St and across the river.
